

What is the best way to display signage? What should it look like?

Provide signage, in both English and Spanish, that instructs operators of trucks and other machinery to not idle for more than 5 minutes.

- The signs are to be a minimum size of 12 inches wide by 18 inches tall.
- They are to be constructed of sturdy materials, preferable metal
- The signs are to be located in direct line of site of where vehicles are expected to park
- The signs are to be placed, on average, at 6' above ground level and easy to see from the seat of the vehicle.
- The signs are to say: 5 MIN IDLE LIMIT

What is the best way to display stickers?

Provide stickers, in both English and Spanish, that instructs operators of trucks and other machinery to not idle for more than 5 minutes. The stickers are to be placed on the dashboard of each construction vehicle.

- The stickers are to be a minimum size of 6 inches wide by 4 inches tall.
- The stickers are to be placed prominently on the dashboard so that both the driver and passenger may see it.
- The signs are to say in English and Spanish:
 - 5 MIN IDLE LIMIT
 - DO NOT IDLE IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT
 - DO NOT IDLE IN FRONT OF OPEN DOORS AND WINDOWS
 - DO NOT IDLE NEAR SCHOOLS
 - DO NOT IDLE WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT
 - DO NOT IDLE NEAR FRESH AIR INTAKE LOUVERS
