Approve an ordinance on second and third readings, creating City Code Chapter 13-7 to enact regulations for vehicle immobilization services (vehicle booting); authorizing related fees; creating offenses; and declaring an emergency.

Additional Backup Information:

Texas House Bill 2065 was passed in May 2017. The law, which fully takes effect on September 1, 2018, largely de-regulates vehicle booting at the state level. Accordingly, all references to booting licenses issued by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation for companies and operators will be removed from state law on September 1, 2018. The state law also specifically

allows municipalities to regulate booting as long as local regulations meet certain minimum requirements. This proposed ordinance regulates the vehicle booting industry in Austin and complies with the minimum regulatory requirements remaining in state law.

On September 14, 2016, as part of the 2016-17 budget process, the City Council adopted the following fees:

Vehicle Immobilization Fee: \$50

Vehicle Immobilization Operator's Permit: \$15.00

Vehicle Immobilization Operator's Permit Replacement: \$11.00
